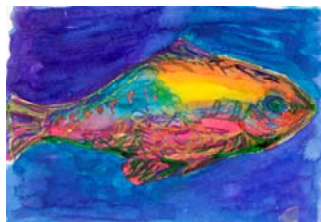

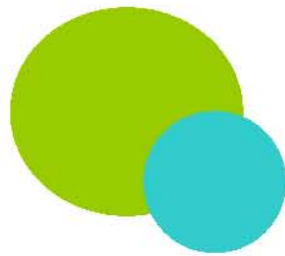

### **Shall we dance?**

116 min      1995      Japanese  
Suo's second feature, this wistful comedy about a Japanese salaryman who discovers the joys of ballroom dancing was hugely successful in its country of origin. Each evening, as he commutes home to his wife and daughter, Shohei Sugiyama, a typically strait-laced Japanese businessmen, catches a glimpse of a beautiful woman gazing out the window of a dance school. Unable to contain his curiosity, he enrolls for classes in order to make contact with her. A snooty ex-professional dancer, she keeps her distance from Sugiyama, but through his newfound love of dancing he befriends a group of people who share his secret passion, including an office colleague who becomes a flamboyant mambo king on the dance floor. Touching and uplifting, the film also offers a subtle critique of restrictive cultural norms in a country where ballroom dancing is regarded as a slightly embarrassing, suspicious past-time because of the close physical proximity of the dancers. ### **Tie me up! Tie me Down! Atame!**

97 min      1990      Spanish; Castilian      **R18+**  
A satiric and explicit look at the battle of the sexes, examining how a man and a woman relate to each other when they are literally 'bound' together. Ricky (Antonio Banderas), a 23 year old ex-psychiatric patient chooses for his wife, Marina, a B-grade and porn movie queen with whom he spent a night during one of his many escapes from the institution. But when Ricky visits Marina on the set of her new movie, she doesn't even recognise him. He figures that his only option is to kidnap her, confident that she will fall in love with him. An audacious and startlingly strangely funny film from Almodovar.

### **D'Artagnan's daughter = La Fille de d'Artagnan**

136 min      1994      French      PGR  
In this historical swashbuckling comedy/adventure set in France in 1654, a feisty young woman (Sophie Marceau), daughter of the famed swordsman D'Artagnan, cuts short her religious studies when she uncovers a plot to assassinate the young Louis XIV. Heading to Paris she persuades her father, now in retirement, and the three other original musketeers to fight alongside her to defend their country from the insurgent forces that threaten to throw the nation into disarray. A lush, lively film assuredly directed by Tavernier that pairs old-fashioned adventure with a contemporary knowing wit and a feminist sensibility. Cast includes Philippe Noiret, Claude Rich and Nils Tavernier.

### **Alexandria, why? = Iskindiria, leh?**

128 min 1979 Arabic Series

**Alexandria Trilogy** (1454) Episode # 1 Synopsis Set against the panoramic backdrop of war-torn Egypt, director Youssef Chahine tells a highly personal tale of love and determination. Yehia is an eighteen-year-old boy living with extended family in Alexandria. His parents, in particular his father, have made great personal sacrifices in order to send their son to expensive schools, in order that he may become an engineer. But Yehia fosters desires and ambitions to be an actor in Hollywood. Despite Yehia's evident commitment, his father dismisses his son's art as a serious prospect. However as Hitler's troops advance toward Egypt, the life that Yehia and his family are accustomed to starts to crumble. Thousands flee, becoming refugees, and as prices inflate ordinary people struggle to cope with wartime rationing. Meanwhile - a group of men, disgruntled by English occupation dispatch various plots, in the hope of assassinating Churchill; a beautiful Jewess falls in love with one would-be-assassin, but her wealthy father wishes them to flee the Nazi threat; a young gay English soldier, terrified of his imminent dispatch to the Front, has an affair with a charming aristocrat. Chahine cleverly intersperses newsreel footage with the lives of his protagonists as they struggle to determine their prospects, whilst also interrogating notions of patriotism and duty versus desire and personal ambition. This autobiographical film was followed by two sequels, "Alexandria again and forever" and "An Egyptian story".

### **An Egyptian story = Hadota Misreya**

122 min 1982 Arabic

**Alexandria Trilogy** (1454) Episode # 2 Synopsis This unusual and fascinating follow-up to "Alexandria, why?" picks up the story of Yehia, the troubled adolescent boy headed for prosperity in America as WWII ravaged his Egyptian homeland. Yehia, now a draconian film director who neglects his wife and children in order to create his work, falls ill and requires open-heart surgery. During the operation a young boy, representing Yehia's conscience, accuses him of betraying his ideals. A metamorphic trial ensues in which various witnesses, including family and colleagues, offer their testimony about "the defendant". These proceedings force the filmmaker to come to terms with hidden emotions involving his life, work and country. Chahine's work examines the politics of the 1952 revolution and its demise in 1967, as well as the frissons that arise as he tries to reconcile his art with his ambitions. This film recalls "Eight and a half" and "All that jazz" in that it examines one man's conscience and history, in a humoristic, satirical and at times, surrealistic, manner. This sequel was followed up by "Alexandria again and forever".

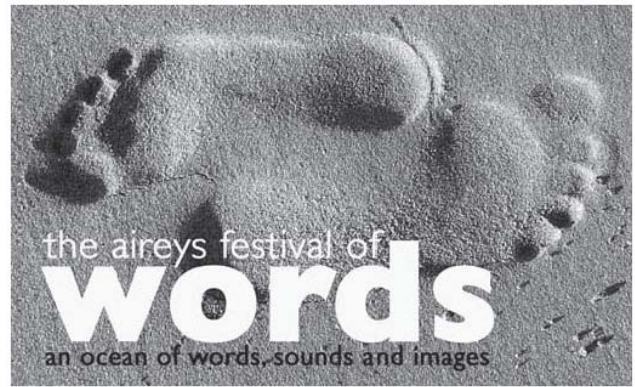
