WENDY GROSE— President

Wendy Grose is an actor and musician. Wendy's numerous credits in theatre and opera include performances with The Royal Opera, Covent Garden, Welsh National Opera, Opera de Lyon, Chamber Made Opera, Back to Back Theatre, The Production Company and the Queensland Theatre Company. She has appeared as a featured recitalist in Britain, Italy, France and Australia, as soloist with orchestras internationally and in broadcasts for the BBC and ABC.

Wendy's television credits include *Blue Heelers*, *Kath and Kim*, *Sea Change*, *Whatever happened to that guy*, *Neighbours* and *Marshall Law*.

With her accompanist, Len Vorster, Wendy has 4 shows currently which tour nationally and internationally (2 comedies, a cabaret and a drama). Wendy was featured in The Weekly Times' Hall of Fame 2002 for her portrayal of inspiring Australian Opera singer, Marjorie Lawrence, in her show "A Different Hat". Wendy was soprano soloist for the Royal Opera Covent Garden's education department, is presently a teaching artist for the Victorian Arts Centre and is on the vocal staff at University of Melbourne and Monash University. She regularly devises and directs productions with diverse community groups and conducts workshops in drama, voice production, French language and diction, singing, and music for people of all ages and abilities.

Wendy regularly performs at festivals nationally and internationally and she has been invited to return to the UK (Brighton Festival) in March 2011 to reprise a role created this year in London with acclaimed innovative UK company, Amici Dance Theatre in 'Tightrope'.

Wendy adores living in the Surf Coast Shire and declares that since moving here, it is the first time she has felt 'homesickness' when away performing. She is very proud to be involved in many aspects of the flourishing local arts community and to currently be president of Surf Coast Arts.

4. Artist's pieces to: hang in trees or be on canvass or board (no glass)
Maximum size 400 mm.
5. Artist's 3D work: not fragile, nor sharp.
6. Artists to be responsible for own work. Can bring chair/ table. Can work. May bring easel for larger work to be displayed, or to use for working on.
To bring own food and drink. Fridge available at Dianne Leslie's, 4 Haydn Court.
7. Cash sales only. Dianne Leslie - receipt provided
8. Set up time 8.30 am. String will be provided.
9. Exhibition will not take place if weather is inclement, or if it is a high fire risk day. (This info will be on advertising)

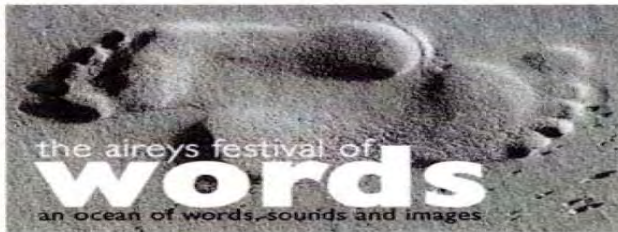
3. Coastal Secrets - A puppet project workshop with Rebecca Hosking

Qdos Arts is delighted to present an amazing evocative collection of work by one of the elder statesmen of Australian painting, Robert Juniper. A contemporary of Fred Williams and John Olsen, Juniper has been proclaimed a living treasure in Western Australia and beyond.

His work is held in all major Australian collections. He was twice won the prestigious Wynne Prize in Sydney and was a finalist in the Doug Moran Portrait Prize with a painting of Olsen.

Returning to Victoria after an absence of 15 years, Robert Juniper is painting, in his own words, 'better than ever'. He is best known for his lyrical depictions of the Western Australian landscape. Robert Juniper's latest work follows a subtle trend to even more delicious colour.
